This session is open to teachers & teaching assistants in mainstream and special settings and parents of pupils of primary and secondary age groups.

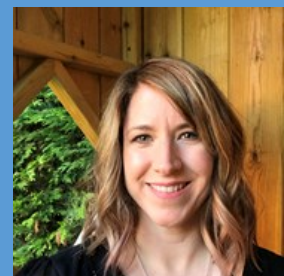
Participants will already have an understanding of Attachment Disorder and wish to deepen their knowledge of developmental trauma.



This session covers:

- to define and understand Attachment and Development Trauma;
- to explore the impact on children and families;
- to consider how to apply it to your work on an everyday basis;
- to consider how to become attachment and trauma-informed as an organisation ;
- first session – foundations/theory;
- second session –practical applications and building on part 1.

Dr Claire Wilson is a clinical psychologist who specialises in working with attachment and developmental trauma in different settings. Following NHS posts in Complex Adult PTSD/post traumatic stress disorder, and managing a Looked After Children team in CAMHS, Dr Wilson now works independently offering therapy, consultation and training. Part of her role is an expert witness in the Family Courts, advising on attachment, developmental trauma and mental health. She also works one day a week in a residential educational setting for young people with autism and challenging behaviour, most of whom are from a looked after background with associated attachment and developmental trauma needs.
